- Collaboration across care continuum




What we did


- Single patient record across all beds and sites
- Click-outs → Pathology, Radiology, Cardiology
- Click-outs → Summary Care Record (My Health Record equivalent)

Benefits



Acute Care

- Reduced variation through digitisation of clinical pathways
- Streamlined ordering (Requests & Results)
 - 375,000 radiology, 1,450,000 pathology orders
- Better results management
 - 97.5% of reports seen within clinical target times, plus audit trail
- Improved decision making
 - Rapid access to test results
- Better clinical charting and care consistency
- Faster patient transfers between wards

Annual savings of £1m (\$1.6 AUD) through reduction in paper From one of the most challenged NHS Trusts to one of the best

Integrated Care

- Information sharing via GP Portal
- Discharge summaries on day of discharge
- Quick access to primary care record


GP Portal


